

OFF-LICENCE

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the Act), **Scott's Brewing Limited** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **1 Wansbeck Street Oamaru 9400** and known as "**Scotts Brewing Company Limited**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

Alcohol may only be sold on the following days and during the following hours:

- 1 Alcohol may be sold or delivered from the premises specified in the licence only on the following days and during the following hours: Monday to Sunday 9.00 am to 10.00 pm.
- 2 No alcohol shall be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- 3 The licensee shall have in place and make available to all staff a host responsibility plan detailing the steps to be taken by the licensee to ensure a safe drinking environment.
- 4 The licensee shall ensure that the provisions of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- 5 A copy of the licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from 1 Wansbeck Street, Oamaru is designated as the principal entrance.
- 6 While alcohol is being supplied free as a sample on the premises drinking water is to be freely available to customers.

The whole of the premises is designated as a supervised area:

THE LICENSED PREMISES

The premises are identified on the plan provided with the application for a licence.

According to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol (Fees) Regulations 2013 fees have been assessed for the premises as Medium.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force:

- a) either:
 - (i) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 12 months after the day it was issued; but
- b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, either:
 - (i) until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed; or
 - (ii) if it has never been renewed, until the close of the period of 4 years after the day it was issued.

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, the licence expires on:

The 28th day of August 2029
